REFLECTIONS FROM TOM...

So ... this is what we discussed in Confirmation Class this week (on ZOOM): "**Worship!**" But it is a vital discussion/reflection for all of us individually, and for us together as Salem Church, especially in these times when getting 'together' is not necessary easy!

We started with a broad definition of the origin of the word, thanks to Wikipedia:

The word is derived from the Old English *weorþscipe*, meaning to venerate "worship, honor shown to an object", which has been etymologized as "worthiness or worth-ship"—to give, at its simplest, worth to something.

We tend to think of Worship as something that we do in one place, on a Sunday, but our Christian Worship is actually everyday, wherever we are, as we converse with God, in thankfulness, in confession, in petition, in joy and in sorrow, about what is real in our living. Coming together, of course, even "virtually" online or otherwise, is of great importance to affirm that covenantal community to which God calls us through our faith.

One great way to "worship" in the everyday, is to offer thankfulness or concern to God "in the moment", for something you experience, for something you are doing through which you learn and grow or are challenged, and sometimes to express your sense of closeness to, or distance from, God. It is all "worship", if you are "conversing" with God.

Did you know that our communal Sunday Worship Services are specifically and intentionally structured to be a "conversation" with God? God does or says something (Call to Worship, Scripture, Assurance of Pardon, Baptism and Communion, even the Sermon!) to us ... and we respond (Prayers of Confession and Thanksgiving, hymns, anthems, offering, doxology, and "Thanks be to God!"). Conversation with God!

A wonderful discipline to get us into the rhythm, the "dance" of daily and communal Sunday Worship ... is a devotional that you can access online, on smartphone or computer or tablet: "d365". It is free, written by many, many diverse people, changes daily, is quick to fit into busy lives, and gives you something to center your day. Try it at www.365.org

These are the members of the Salem Church Pastor Search Committee, selected by Council from among those nominated by members of the Congregation:

Brad Bergin, Kathy Hauser, Krista Nechvatal, Jon Pundt, Angela Quade, Karen Williams, and Brian Winterle. They will be advised and resourced along the way by Rev. Tom Robinson (Interim Pastor, during the pre-Candidate phase) and by Rev. Ted Drewsen and Rev. Amy Lunde-Whitler from the Southwest Association of the Wisconsin Conference of the United Church of Christ.

We had hoped and expected to introduce the Committee to the Congregation on January 16th, at Sunday Worship in the Salem Church Sanctuary, but the Omicron surge interrupted that plan. We WILL have a formal Commissioning of the Committee once back for onsite worship, but for now, the Search Committee has already begun meeting "virtually" each week. Leadership and tasks chosen from among the Committee include: Jon as Chairperson, with Krista as backup Chair when needed; Brian, Secretary; Angela, Communications; Krista and Karen, Announcements; Kathy, Profile writing; and Brad, Committee Chaplain. Of course, each member will carry out these specific leading roles, but also support each other in every role, and do numerous other tasks. Among those other tasks will be reaching out to groups and individuals and families for input, surveys, discussion, and discernment. We will not only need to assess who we are currently as a Church in worship and mission, but also how and in what ways God will call us into future ministry within our congregation and community, as well as beyond ourselves. This will all go into the Church Profile, which is what potential Pastoral Candidates will first read to learn about Salem Church.

Please be in constant prayer for the individual members of the Search Committee and for the Committee as a whole. This is a very important responsibility and a multi-faceted process. Salem Church will be regularly kept informed of the stages through which the Search Process is moving and deeply involved in the data and profile information gathering. However, the internal workings of the Search Committee will necessarily be confidential, especially once actual Candidates for Pastor are in dialogue with the Search Committee. Thank you for your love, prayers, and support of our Search Committee along this pivotal journey of searching for Salem Church's next "settled" (permanent) Pastor!

BOARD OF CHRISTIAN EDUCATION (BOCE)

The BoCE oversees all aspects of the Christian Education offerings at Salem: Sunday School for all ages, Palm Sunday Pilgrimage, Vacation Bible School (all ages), Christmas program, Parent's Promise, Koinonia and other adult small groups. In consultation with the Director of Christian Education, this advisory committee provides guidance for the content and structure of Sunday school and other programming. We are shifting from a model where the members of the BoCE provide the volunteer service for this programming, and they will now solely serve in an advisory capacity. This important church committee is mandated in the Salem church constitution.

We need you! This committee is more important than ever. As we search for a new pastor and try to grow our church, a strong BoCE provides the backbone for our education ministries and sends a clear message that we are a vibrant and engaged congregation. No previous experience required, and anyone who believes in the value of Christian Education is welcome.
